A program to distribute house agreements to the residents being rehabilitated under the Slum Rehabilitation Authority in Bandra East was held at the Mumbai Suburban District Collectorate. District Collector of Mumbai Suburban District Rajendra Khirsagar, senior officers and employees were present on this occasion. Guardian Minister Adv. Shelar said that this project is being successfully completed with the cooperation of the Chief Minister, Deputy Chief Minister, Housing Minister and concerned officials. Efforts will be made to ensure



that the residents enter their new homes before the Ganpati festival. Stating that a decision has been taken to hand over 30.16 acres of land owned by the Public Works Department in Bandra East to the High Court, Guardian Minister Adv. Shelar said that the Slum Rehabilitation Authority has made available a total of 144 flats, including 77 flats of Omsai Cooperative Housing Society and 67 flats of Balaji Shop Keepers in Bandra East, to the government after following up.
